Chiefs,

After my email last night, I have received a couple of calls with questions, including about the email you all received from FPCA asking you to sign the street 287(g) taskforce MOA.

To say all of this immigration stuff is confusing is an understatement. It is also at the forefront of Florida politics and an absolute priority of the Governor. The new law puts legal obligations on all of us to ensure we do certain things and the consequences for not doing so include removal from office by the Governor, including his power to remove police chiefs, city managers, mayors, and commission/council members.

There is a lot to explain and too much for an email. I will do a call tonight at 5:00 p.m. for anyone who wants to join and hear about the current immigration landscape in Florida, including more about these administrative warrants and provide you my thoughts on how to best comply with the new Florida law. Feel free to have any members of your command staffs who you feel may benefit from hearing about this on the call too.
